North End Transportation Committee
Purpose & Structure

Purpose: The purpose of The Committee is to advocate for the objectives outlined in the District 6 Large Area Plan regarding transportation, address issues related to transportation infrastructure, public right-of-way, multi-modal options, safety, mobility and livability. The Committee also gathers information on transportation-related issues in the North End neighborhood; to disseminate information and gather feedback from the community on transportation-related issues when appropriate; to track, discuss, and debate transportation-related issues; and to provide information and recommendations for action to the District 6 Land Use Task Force (LUTF), District 6 Planning Council, and/or City-County agencies as appropriate.

Membership: The Committee will have up to 9 members, including at least one LUTF member and up to 8 members of the community-at-large (residents, business owners, representatives of institutions, etc.). At least two thirds of committee members must be residents of the North End neighborhood.

Appointment: All members will be appointed by the LUTF. Anyone interested in joining must: 1) Attend at least one North End Transportation Committee meeting; 2) Complete a membership application form and return it to the District 6 office. The LUTF will review the application at the next regularly scheduled board meeting. The LUTF will strive to ensure that a range of interests and perspectives are represented on The Committee.

Terms of Service: Committee members are appointed to a term that ends in January of the year following their appointment or reappointment. In January of each year, the LUTF will reappoint all sitting committee members in good standing who wish to be reappointed. Members can be reappointed for an unlimited number of terms, but the LUTF is under no obligation to reappoint committee members.

Removal: Members serve at the pleasure of the LUTF and can be removed from The Committee by a simple majority vote of the LUTF at any regularly scheduled meeting for any of the following reasons as determined by fellow committee members: excessive absences, failure to prepare for meetings, disruptive behavior during meetings, or any other legitimate reason as determined by members of the committee.

Meetings: A regular meeting time, date, and location will be determined by committee members at the first meeting of the year following appointments/reappointments.

Committee Leadership: The Committee will select a Chair, who will set the agenda for the meeting, communicate the agenda to the membership, and preside over meetings; a vice-Chair, who will serve as Chair as needed; and a Secretary, who will record the minutes of committee activities and communicate those minutes to the membership. To insure a strong communications link between the committee and the LUTF, the Chair, the vice-Chair, or the Secretary must be a LUTF member.
